

Hurricane Bill's passage through the area prompted us to remind members of the marina policies regarding dangerous storms. If our forecast includes a high probability of tropical storm force winds or greater (39+ mph), a mandatory marina evacuation may be ordered. Notice of evacuation will be spread by email and phone and we will attempt to provide 24 hours of notice. Be aware that 24 hrs may not be possible due to the uncertain track and pace of these storms. This list contains some of the things you should do to make CPYC's response to storms orderly, effective and safe:

- 1) Know the location of your storm mooring and be prepared to use it with very little warning.
- 2) Pay close attention to weather forecasts. If you are going to be unavailable during times when a storm is threatening, please move to your mooring before you become indisposed.
- 3) Ensure that your contact information is accurate and pay close attention to your messages when storms are nearby. If you doubt the accuracy of our information, you can update our records by sending email to secretary@cpyc.org or calling the club (617-846-2792) and leaving a message.
