**NOTICE OF RACE & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**  
**AUGUST 1 - 2, 2009**

**1. RULES**

- 1.1.** The Cottage Park Yacht Club Regatta to benefit Make-A-Wish will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing, 2009 – 2012*.
- 1.2.** The rules of the 210, Star, Rhodes 19, Thistle, Thunderbird, Snipe, Vanguard 15 and Laser classes will apply.
- 1.3.** By participating in this regatta, a competitor grants to the organizing authority and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.

- 2. ADVERTISING** – Shall be restricted to Category A in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20, Advertising Code, and the relevant class rules.

**3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY**

**3.1. US SAILING MEMBERSHIP**

Membership in US SAILING is recommended for each competitor (helmsman and crew for double handed classes). Sailors can join online at [www.ussailing.org/membership](http://www.ussailing.org/membership).

**3.2. CLASS ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP**

It is recommended that competitors be members of their respective class associations.

**4. BOATS/COURSE**

- 4.1.** Eligible classes are: 210, Star, Rhodes 19, Thistle, Thunderbird, Snipe, Vanguard 15 and Laser classes
- 4.2.** Competitors shall bring their own boats, dollies and tow boat, etc.
- 4.3.** Each competitor will be responsible for his or her boat being in compliance with the class rules. The class rules will be used, except that RRS 60.1(a) is changed to prohibit a boat from protesting another boat for an alleged breach of a class rule requiring class membership or imposing a weight limit.
- 4.4.** The course area will be in Winthrop/Boston waters between Deer Island and Logan Airport.
- 4.5.** Marks of the course shall be inflatable drop marks or government marks.
- 4.6.** The courses will be Windward/Leeward, Olympic or Gold Cup courses.

- 5. FEES** - The early registration fee for all classes is \$75.00 per boat. Early registration is strongly recommended. Late registrations (postmarked after Saturday 7/25/2009), will make an additional donation to Make a Wish of \$25.00 per boat. The entry fee includes one ticket for the Saturday Night Dinner.

**8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** - The sailing instructions will be available at registration and on the web at [www.cpyc.org](http://www.cpyc.org).

**9. SCORING** – The Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A of the RRS will apply. As many races as possible will be scheduled, of which one shall be completed to constitute a series. If six or more races are sailed, a boat's worst score shall be discarded.

**10. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS** – Notice to Competitors will be posted on the Official Notice Board located in the ballroom of CPYC. They may also be posted at [www.cpyc.org](http://www.cpyc.org) under Make A Wish Regatta.

**11. CHANGES TO THIS NRSI** – Will be posted before 9AM on the day it will take effect.

**12. SAFETY**

All competitors are strongly encouraged to wear PFDs on the water. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**13. PRIZES** – Make-A-Wish trophies will be awarded to competitors placing first through third in all divisions.
