4.1 RULES: This *Event* will be governed by the MBSA General Sailing Instructions except as changed by these Event Sailing Instructions.

5.1 NOTICE TO COMPETITORS: None

7.1 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE: At Cottage Park Yacht Club and VHF radio channel 72

8.1 SCHEDULE of RACES: 15 races over the season divided into 3 series, five races each. One race an evening.

8.2: START TIME: The warning signal will be made at 1830 hrs. The warning signal in September will be at 1800 hrs

10.1 RACING AREA: Start in the vicinity of Yellow Nun "E", 1.5 miles west of Deer Island Light.

11.1 THE COURSE: Intended courses to be used are MBSA standard courses or MBSA list of Marks "C"

12.1 MARKS: Government Marks per MBSA List "C", inflatable tetrahedrons, or CPYC circulars.

15.2 RECALLS: The race committee will use the VHF Channel 72.

18.1 TIME LIMIT: The time limit for each class shall be two hours. The Finishing Window will be 30 minutes after the first boat finishes in each class.

27.1 PRIZES: Prizes will be presented at CPYC Annual Awards Night to be held in conjunction with Mass Bay Sailing Awards dinner at CPYC on Friday, November 19, 2010.

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS: Each boat must identify itself by coming within hailing distance of the Race Committee signal boat prior to the beginning of its class starting sequence, but not within five (5) minutes of the start of the prior class. Please approach the Race Committee for a course sheet.
