## NOTICE OF RACE

For One Design Classes Saturday, June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2004

- SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Racing will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2001-04 (RRS) prescriptions of US Sailing, Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions, and each One Design and Class Association's rules except as modified herein or posted before 8AM on the day of the race at CPYC bulletin board or CPYC website [www.cpyc.org](http://www.cpyc.org) as of 0900 Saturday, June 5, 2004 at CPYC Clubhouse.
- SKIPPER'S MEETING:** 0900 Saturday June 5, 2004 at CPYC Clubhouse.  
1030 Saturday June 5, 2004 for Thistle Class.
- SCHEDULE OF RACES:** Weather permitting, there will be **two** or **three** races on Saturday.
- STARTING SIGNAL:** 1100 hrs First Warning Signal for First Class.  
1200 hrs First Warning Signal for Thistle Class on Saturday.
- CLASS FLAGS:** One Design starts will be designated by their class flag class insignia.
- STARTING LINE:** To be announced at Skipper's Meeting.
- CHECK IN:** Boats are required to check-in before their first start. Boats in the racing area that are **not** starting a second or subsequent race **must** so notify the Race Committee **before** leaving the racing area. Boats that withdraw from racing **must** advise the Race Committee as soon as reasonably possible.
- RACE COURSE(S):** This regatta will use government navigational aids inside Boston Harbor, "dropped" orange tetrahedron marks, or any combination thereof as course racing marks. A list of all possible government Boston Harbor navigational aids that can be used as racing marks will be available at the Skipper's Meeting. Thistle Class will use exclusively the "dropped" marks.
- The course(s) for each race and starting sequence will be posted on the Race Committee boat.
- TIME LIMIT:** 3hrs after start of class race.

- SCORING:** Low point. Ties broken by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2001-04 (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing.
- AWARDS:** Prizes will be awarded to the first, second, and third place boats of each class in the combined scoring of all races. Prizes will be presented at the CPYC Annual Awards Night to be announced at a later date. Additionally, the names of first place winners of each class will be added to the Perpetual JFK Trophy at CPYC.
- BBQ AND SOCIAL EVENTS:** The CPYC Pilot House will be open after the races, offering hospitality to all captains, their crew, and guests. A barbeque will be held at CPYC after the race for captains and crew. (The barbeque is included in the entry fee for captain and ONE crew. Additional guests may attend the barbeque for \$5.00 each.)
- FREE MOORINGS:** Free overnight moorings are available to long distance race participants. Please contact and coordinate your needs with the CPYC Launch Operator via VHF Channel 78.
- CPYC LAUNCH SERVICE:** Launch service to take regatta participants and crew back and forth from their moorings and the CPYC dock will be available on Friday night until 8:00pm. The launch service will start again at 9:00am on Saturday morning and run thru 8:00pm. It will resume again on Sunday at 9:00am. (Use VHF Channel 78 to contact the CPYC Launch Operator.)
- CRANE AVAILABILITY:** CPYC has an electric hoist/crane with up to 2000 lb. lifting capacity that is suitable for launching and retrieving small one-design boats such as the Star, Rhodes 19, Thistle, and Snipe. Please coordinate any need of this resource with the CPYC Launch Operator.
- ENTRY FEES:** One Design \$35. Entry fee includes 2 barbeque tickets. Additional barbeque tickets are available for \$5.00 each. Thistle Class \$55 which includes 3 barbeque tickets.
