NOTICE OF RACE

For PHRF & J105 Classes Saturday, June 5th, 2004

- SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Mass Bay Sailing Instructions except as modified herein or posted before 8am, on the day of the race, at the CPYC bulletin board and the CPYC website (www.cpyc.org).
- STARTING SIGNAL:** 1100 hrs First Warning Signal for First Class.
- CLASS FLAGS:** Class flags for each class will be the code flag for the letter Class Flags. J105 & any other one-design starts will be designated by their class flag class insignia.
- CHECK IN:** Boats are required to check-in before their first start. Boats in the racing area that are **not** starting a second or subsequent race must so notify the Race Committee **before** leaving the racing area. Boats that withdraw from racing **must** advise the Race Committee as soon as reasonably possible.
- STARTING AREA:** Vicinity of Racing Mark "M", Boston Entrance Gong RW "NC".
- COURSE(S):** Maximum of 3 races. Courses for each race will be designated by letters or numbers from the list of the Mass Bay Sailing standard racing courses and posted on the RC Boat. All attempts will be made to broadcast it over VHF Channel 72.
- TIME LIMIT:** 3hrs after start of class.
- SPECIAL CONDITIONS:** The Race Committee will monitor VHF Channel 72 from 1100 until all boats have finished the last race, or three hours from the start of the last race of the day. Communications will **NOT** be acknowledged during the starting sequence unless marine safety is involved.
- SCORING:** Low point. Ties will be broken by Mass Bay Sailing-ORC scoring system (Combined corrected times).
- AWARDS:** Prizes will be awarded to the first, second, and third place boats of each class in the combined scoring of all races. Prizes will be presented at the CPYC Annual Awards Night to be announced at a later date. Additionally, the names of first place winners of each class will be added to the Perpetual JFK Trophy at CPYC.

BBQ AND SOCIAL EVENTS: The CPYC Pilot House will be open after the races, offering hospitality to all captains, their crew, and guests. A barbeque will be held at CPYC after the last race for captains and crew. (The barbeque is included in the entry fee for captain and TWO crew. Additional guests may attend the barbeque for \$5.00 each.)

FREE MOORINGS: Free overnight moorings are available to long distance race participants. Please contact and coordinate your needs with the CPYC Launch Operator via VHF Channel 78.

CPYC LAUNCH SERVICE: Launch service to take regatta participants and crew back and forth from their moorings and the CPYC dock will be available on Friday night until 8:00pm. The launch service will start again at 9:00am on Saturday morning and run thru 8:00pm. It will resume again on Sunday at 9:00am. (Use VHF Channel 78 to contact the CPYC Launch Operator.)

ENTRY FEES: PHRF: \$50. U.S. Sailing Member: \$45. Entry fee includes 3 barbeque tickets. Additional barbeque tickets are available for \$5.00 each.
